

# Filtering Articles by Date - 1 of 3 July Improvements to Publications Search Results

Newsletter readers will be thrilled that the search now lets them simply switch between results for publications and codesets with no search word or code reentry. In addition, they can filter results by any publication date.

**Bonus:** Latest search results will be saved so you can quickly return to a previous search without having to reenter the search term or code.
